## **Bobbie Holsclaw Presents \$2,466,988 Check to Metro Government**

### **Over Nine and a Half Million Returned To Metro Government During Sixteen Year Period**

(Louisville, KY ~ June 25, 2015) Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk, presented a check to Louisville/Jefferson County Metro for **\$2,466,988.62** as surplus from her fourth administrative term (2011-2014).

Unlike other publicly held offices that operate with a budget, the County Clerk is mandated by Kentucky statutes to close their four-year term with a balanced budget, or the Clerk is held personally responsible for the deficit. In Bobbie's first term as County Clerk (1999-2002) she returned a surplus of **\$2,744,957.86** to the county; her second term surplus was **\$2,530,392.50** and her third term surplus was **\$1,917,251.34**.

The total returned to Jefferson County from her 16 years as Jefferson County Clerk now totals **\$9,659,590.32**

Holsclaw said, "Only when an expenditure directly benefits the residents of Jefferson County, is it to be considered. I believe that sound fiscal policy is the key to good governance. As an office, we have been able to maintain and improve the services we deliver to the citizens of Jefferson County and still keep focused on the bottom line."
