Louisville, KY --- It has been recommended that Kentuckians should avoid crowds, large sporting events, community gatherings and areas where waiting time can be required. All of this to prevent community spread of the novel coronavirus.

Annually Jefferson County residents must renew their car tags during their birthday month. A postcard notice is sent from the Kentucky Department of Transportation as a reminder. Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk is recommending to individuals who want to avoid the waiting areas at the eight-motor vehicle branches to consider one of the other renewal options available to them.
