Compensation Increases to \$300 for completing training, duties

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (8/10/2022): In appreciation of the vital work Election Officer poll workers do to ensure all qualified voters can participate in the free, fair, and secure balloting process, the Jefferson County Board of Elections has raised Election Officer compensation from \$200 to \$300 for working the upcoming General Election, Jefferson County Clerk and Chairperson of the Board of Elections Bobbie Holsclaw shared today.

"Our Election Officer poll workers make up the front line of democracy, and their help is critical in ensuring all eligible members of our community can make their voices heard at the ballot box," said Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk. "It's important to let those who step up for this important civic duty know we value their efforts. We hope those who have staffed polling locations before not only feel called to serve again, but also that this change encourages first-time Election Officers to sign up and preserve the right to vote."

Election Officer poll workers will receive \$40 for attending a 2.5 hour training session and \$260 for working their election assignment on Election Day, November 8.
